2023 Rules for Becoming a Miss DC Contestant

To participate in the 2023 Miss District of Columbia competition, a contestant must fulfill the following requirements:

- A contestantmust be 18-28 years of age toparticipate in the MissDC competition. She must be at least 8 on the first day on which she is a contestant in any phase of the MissDC competition. She may not turn 29 by the end of the calendar year in which she competes for the MissDC title. For the 2023 Miss DC competition, contestants must be born AFTER December 31, 1994 and BEFORE June 10, 2005. A copy of the candidate sbirth certificate must be provided to the Miss District of Columbia Organization.
- Inorder toparticipate in the Miss District of Columbia competition, and testant must reside in be enrolled in and attending classes on a full-time basis at an accredited college/university in or a graduating high school senior in; or beemployed inonafull-time basis, the District of Columbia (DC suburbs of Maryland and Virginia do not suffice).
- If sheisclaiming eligibility toparticipate in the Miss District of Columbia competition based upon her residence in the District of Columbia, a contestant ust have been resident of of Columbia daysprior to the Miss District of the District for at least 90 Columbia competition A contestant must provide proof of this residency in the formof a driver's license, automobile registration, current lease optherofficial document that establishes residency. If her residencyatthis locationwas established within 90 days preceding the Miss District of Columbia competition, she must provide proof of previous residency in the District of Columbia. A contestantnust agree to provide the Miss District of Columbia Organization additional information or documentsthat may be required to determine her residency in the anv District of Columbiaif her residence is relevant toher eligibility. Shemust present payroll statementsor aletter fromher employer tothiseffect. contestants must be able to prove employment onor before For the 2023Miss DC competition, April 11, 2023.
- Whatever type of eligibility she is claiming, the eligibility must be maintained through the Miss District of Columbia competition.
- A contestantmust be female.
- A contestantmust be a U.S. citizen.
- A contestant must not ever have been married and may not marry during her year of service.
- A contestant may not currently be pregnant or become pregnant during her year of service.
- A contestantmust be in reasonably good health and able to participate fullyinany program activities.
